Below is information regarding 24/7 Drug Disposal Sites in Rhode Island. Prescription drugs may be disposed at the following locations. Unless otherwise indicated, anyone may use these services, they are available at any time and the disposal site is a box or bin in the lobby of the address listed.

All phone numbers listed here are for routine/general inquiries. For emergencies, call 911.
