






#### **RACE/ETHNICITY (2010)**







#### Middle School Prescription Drug Use 2012-2013





#### Middle School Marijuana Use 2012-2013





#### Middle School Inhalant Use 2012-2013





Middle School Other Illegal Drug Use 2012-2013





#### Middle School Ever Alcohol Use 2012-2013







#### Middle School Current Alcohol Use 2012-2013





#### Middle School Moderate Alcohol Use 2012-2013





#### Middle School Ever Smoked 2012-2013










#### High School Current Prescription Drug Use 2012-2013







#### High School Cocaine Use 2012-2013











#### High School Current Alcohol Use 2012-2013









#### High School Ever Smoked 2012-2013












