




POPULATION PER SQUARE MILE IN RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITIES 2016




GENDER DISTRIBUTION IN RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITIES 2016



AGE DISTRIBUTION IN RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITIES 2016




RACIAL/ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION IN RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITIES 2016



UNEMPLOYMENT (%) IN RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITIES 2016





BELOW FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL (%) IN RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITIES 2016




POPULATION PER SQUARE MILE IN RHODE ISLAND REGIONS 2016




GENDER DISTRIBUTION IN RHODE ISLAND REGIONS 2016



AGE DISTRIBUTION IN RHODE ISLAND REGIONS 2016




RACIAL/ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION IN RHODE ISLAND REGIONS 2016




