What is Narcan?

Narcan® (Naloxone) is a safe medication that can save someone's life by reversing the effects of an opioid overdose. The medication is designed to counteract an overdose of opioids, such as heroin, prescription painkillers, and fentanyl, but it is safe to use even if opioids are not present. If you are worried you or someone you know may be at risk of an opioid overdose, Narcan is available to you. It is highly encourage that families or individuals who are being prescribed opioids are trained on how to administer Narcan in the case of an emergency.
