HONORING OFFICER BOURQUE

The 2026 Move with MADD event is dedicated in loving memory of Jamestown Police Officer Ryan J. Bourque, whose life was tragically taken by an impaired driver on May 23, 2016—10 years to the day of this event.

That Monday was meant to mark a milestone for Ryan: his one-year anniversary as a patrol officer with the Jamestown Police Department. Instead, in the early hours just after midnight, as Ryan drove home to Coventry following the end of his shift, his vehicle was struck head-on by a wrong-way driver on Interstate 95 South near Exit 7 in West Greenwich, killing both motorists. Ryan was just 24 years old.
